Roads Explained

Shipshewana county roads can be a little confusing!

•The county roads are based on the distance in miles from US 20 and State Road 9 (SR 9)

• The East & West roads are east and west of SR 9

• The North & South roads are north and south of US 20

• Example: •200 North means 2 miles North of US 20, and 200

South is 2 miles South of US 20. Same applies to East to West of SR 9.

Driving Tips • Understand the Grid! Road names and numbers can be

confusing. Road names are based on the distance in miles from US 20 and State Road 9 (SR 9): • The East & West roads are east and west of SR 9. The

North & South roads are north and south of US 20. · Use a Map! Make sure and get a printed map and assign a

navigator to help enhance the experience.

• Take it Slow! Watch for buggies, pedestrians and bicyclists on the roads. Some roads are bumpier than others and may be gravel, all of which require slower driving, but add to the cultural experience.

• Stop and enjoy! You'll pass by LOTS of great roadside stands, Amish Cottage shops and Barn Quilts, perfect for an Amish Country Adventure. Feel free to stop and re-start the audio anytime, even extending it over several days, so you can really enjoy.

• Do the speed limit! The audio tour is timed for you to follow the speed limit and with no buggies on the road. You might find you are ahead or behind the narrator, especially if you get behind a buggy or bike, but don't get frustrated. Simply pause the recording until you get to the next turn and catch up.

• Plan! Store hours in Amish Country may vary. Amish-

owned businesses have limited hours, are closed after 5 and are closed on Sunday for them to be with their family.






