10:00 am - 12:00 pm - Discover The Downtown Hallmark-like Shopping District

Get all of your holiday gifts on a shopping spree in downtown Shipshewana! Experience millions of twinkling lights, boughs, baubles, bangles, and decor. Set your own pace and take a leisurely, self-guided tour of locally-owned shops. Choose between the four-story historic Davis Mercantile with a vintage carousel on the top floor or find locally-made crafts and decor along Morton and Harrison Streets. 12:15 pm - 1:30 pm - Lunch and Christmas Cookie Decorating at Shawna Rae's Bakery & Cafe

Decorate Christmas Cookies with Chef Shawna Rae. A local farmer turned chef, entrepreneur, and caterer, Shawna Rae offers baked goods and fresh soups, salads, and sandwiches. Make sure you leave with a slice of one of the daily made gourmet cheesecakes or a cupcake (or two).

1:45 pm - 3:00 pm - Visit Teaberry Wood Products and create a Wooden Christmas Ornament

Linda and her family will serve an authentic Amish-cooked meal of grilled pork chops, potatoes, homemade noodles, vegetables, salad, homemade bread and pies. It's a one-of-a-kind, unique experience to dine on a family farm, enjoying freshly prepared food and hearing family-favorite stories of their Christmas celebrations. End the meal with an Amish song, play a festive game of Christmas Bingo, and leave with a full belly.

6:30 - 8:00 pm - Lights of Joy Drive Through Display

There's no better way to experience the holiday season than driving through the Shipshewana Lights of Joy! This spectacular event features two million LED lights and displays along a mile-and-a-half path through a symphony of colorful scenes.

12:15 pm - 1:15 pm Lunch & Make a pretzel at Ben's Pretzels

Enjoy a short presentation highlighting Ben's amazing story and his multimillion-dollar company. Ben's Pretzels was founded in 2004 by 3rd gen local Amish bakers, Ben and Elizabeth Miller, who spent

years perfecting the preservative-free Amish/Dutch soft dough recipe pretzel. Roll your own pretzel and watch it being baked before your eyes. Choose your favorite dipping sauce and be transported to Pretzel Paradise at first bite!





1:30 pm - 2:30 pm - Menno-Hof Amish Mennonite Interpretive Cultural Center

The Menno-Hof is an important and delightful first stop before taking in the rich landscape and gentle charm of the Shipshewana area. Learn about the history and culture of the Amish and how LaGrange County is the third-largest Amish settlement in the US. Take a guided tour of the museum and encounter immersive multimedia presentations and hands-on displays about the faith and life of the Amish and Mennonites. Visit the gift shop for handcrafted items made by local crafters.

2:45 pm - 3:15 pm - Yoder's Meat & Cheese Co

Get an inside look at locally-owned Yoder's Meat & Cheese Co. for your holiday food shopping. Learn how four generations have worked to bring top-quality meat from farm to your table. Specializing in locally-raised Beef, Buffalo, Pork, Poultry, and Lamb, all naturally fed, without hormones, steroids, or by-products. Fill your holiday table with 80 varieties of cheese, 150 cuts of meat, in-house smoked meats including "the world's best bacon!" and gourmet specialty foods.

3:30 pm - 4:30 pm - Pop over to Yoder Popcorn

Give the gift of popcorn and stuff your stockings full of flavorful varieties. In 1936, Rufus Yoder started growing popcorn locally on the family farm. In the Amish custom, he shared his excess crop with his neighbors and friends, and now, generations later, the family continues to market this farm-fresh, delicious snack.
